

## Winter Banners 2020: Call for Art

### Program overview

1. We will be accepting entries December 1, 2019 through January 31, 2020. Entries will then be reviewed and banners will be printed and hung for the 2020 holiday season.
2. You may submit up to four entries of different designs. Multiple entries does not guarantee higher likelihood of being chosen.
3. For each design chosen, the artist will receive \$100.
4. We are looking for artwork that fits the theme of winter.

### Preparing & submitting your artwork

5. Materials must be submitted to the Alpena DDA office by January 31, 2020.
6. Entries may be submitted in either digital or paper format according to necessary size requirements. It is the entrant's responsibility to pick up their entry at the DDA Office after announcements have been made.
7. Digital entries may be emailed to [downtownalpenami@gmail.com](mailto:downtownalpenami@gmail.com).
8. Submitted artwork must be the artists' original creation. If art is a copy of another artist's work or copyrighted art, the submission will be deemed ineligible. Please refrain from using any copyrighted images or characters.
9. Entries may not be photography or have any text on them.
10. Submissions must fit the dimensions of 20 inches wide by 40 inches tall. Scaled down versions may be submitted.

11. Images may be enhanced for printing purposes or cropped in order to fit the space if not submitted in necessary size.

### Terms & conditions

12. All contestants and/or guardians will be required to agree to these Terms & Conditions.
13. By submitting artwork, each contestant and/or guardian consents to the use of his/her name and/or artwork in any merchandise, advertisements, educational materials, or publicity carried out by the DDA or partnering arts organizations without further notice or compensation. The committee can publish or decline to publish, use or not use any submitted artwork on their discretion.
14. The contestant and/or guardian still retains the rights to use and publish their artwork.
15. The contest's rulings are final and without appeal in all matters related to this contest. The contest is subject to all federal, provincial, and municipal laws and regulations.
16. Entrants agree to release and hold harmless the Alpena DDA and any employees, officers, directors, representatives, successors, and any related agencies from any liability for any loss or damage of any kind to the entrant or any other person in connection with the contest or related activities.
